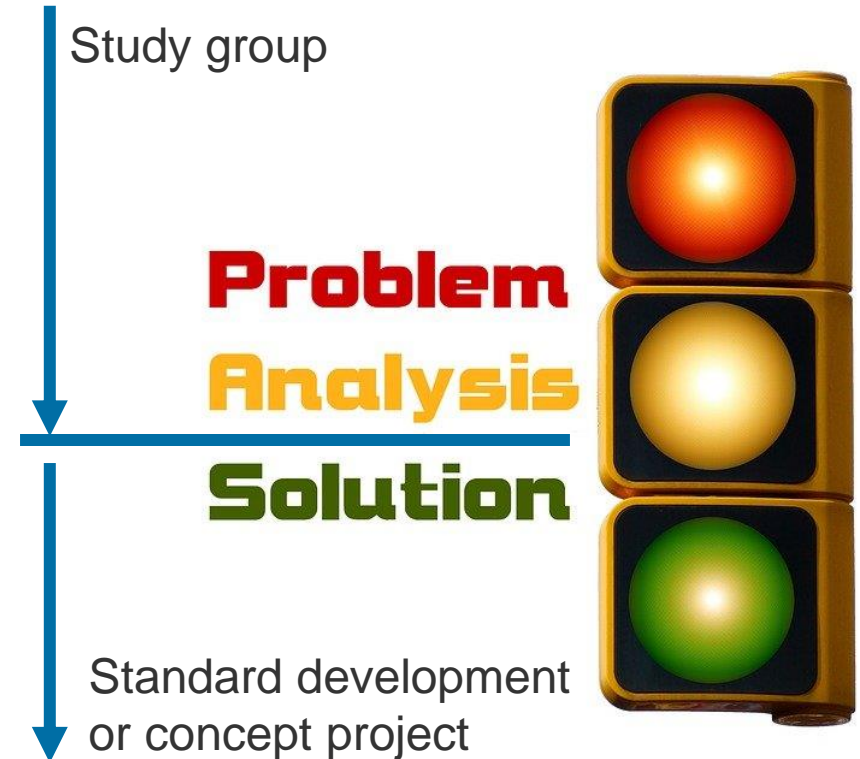

What is a Study Group at ASAM?

- A group of industry experts that regularly meets to gain an improved understanding of the [standardization landscape](#) for some pre-defined topic(s) through discussion and analysis
- Narrow, focused scope
- Non-competitive environment
- Output → Documentation, e.g. whitepaper, guidelines, recommendations



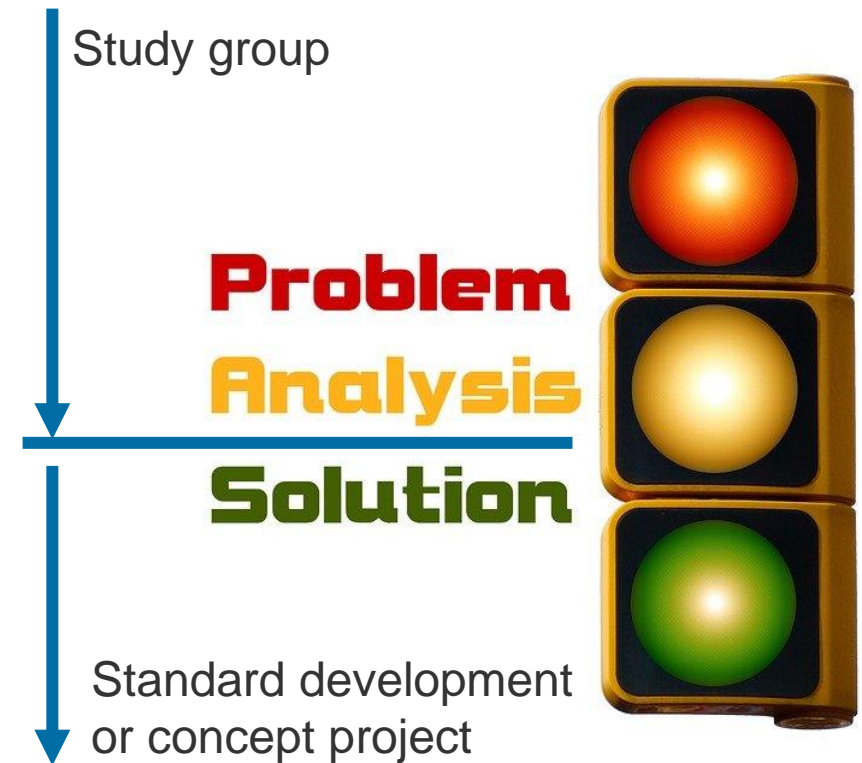
What is a Study Group at ASAM?

DO's in a Study Group

- Define the scope
- Understand the problem
- Research within scope
- Discuss, compare and document the results

DONT's in a Study Group

- Develop a solution
- Implement tooling
- Develop a standard or concept



Some Takeaways

- This study group is supposed to develop an overview of a landscape – don't get lost in unnecessary conceptual or implementation level details
- Keep an open mind
 - This group is aiming to understand different perspectives and toolchains
→ How do they differ / how are they alike?
 - It is not aiming to define the one and only solution
- Aim to foster a common understanding of terms to avoid problems when communicating your perspectives
